Subject: Transportation to Columbus

Columbus Feb. 6, 1844

Miss Mary

We have some prospect of engaging Col. Pinney to bring us down Thursday, if he can procure a suitable carriage -- in which case you can return with him the same evening, or remain until Saturday evening or Sunday morning -- If I should be as much confined Saturday as I am sometimes, I should not be able to go in time, but if you remain, I will take you in a buggy Sunday morning, and that to with the greatest pleasure, and at the same time much regretting that circumstances will prevent my going with you sooner.

I write this much so that you may prepare accordingly.
