"Faith For Today."




LOIS HOLMES

Television audiences have seen Miss Holmes on Hallmark, U.S. Steel, The Nurses, The Defenders, Edge of Night and The Secret Storm. In Summer theatres she has appeared with such stars as Ed Begley, Vivian Blaine, Lee Grant and Vivian Vance. On tour she played Mrs. Bedwin in the National Company of "Oliver," also appeared as Mrs. Mac Elleny with Shirley Booth in "Time of the Cuckoo" at Central City Drama Festival.

GARY GARTH

is returning for his third season at POG, having spent the past winter on tour throughout the country, appearing at universities and colleges in a production of the Greek tragedy "Antigone." He was also production manager for a troupe of literary cabaret singers from the Left Bank in Paris. A native of Ohio, he studied drama at Western Reserve University in Cleveland and in New York with Herbert Berghof and Uta Hagen.

ABOUT THE PLAY . . . "Everything in the Garden" is a scornful and comic picture of an outwardly respectable, well-to-do group of people, all willing to sell anything — but anything — in order to keep up with their neighbors spending habits. None of the acidulous speech that characterized Albee's most celebrated hit, "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?" is in this melodrama-thriller-comedy, but it does contain his customary brand of devastating mockery of human foibles.

ABOUT THE AUTHOR . . . In the early 1960's Edward Albee rocketed to the position of the most notable and most discussed new serious playwright to spring to prominence in the American theater since the appearance of Tennessee Williams and Arthur Miller thirteen years earlier. The Pulitzer Prize winner has had one success after another — "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?", "Tiny Alice," "A Delicate Balance," and now "Everything in the Garden."



RICHARD HIGGS


